

Online Exhibit Call: Functional COVID Art Mask

Photo Submission Deadline: September 30, 2020

Calling all AAFG artists!

Dust off your creative brains, hearts, and hands, and use your mask making skills to fashion a Functional COVID Art Mask! You may use any mask pattern you like but make it your own. Use your favorite fiber art technique: weave, embroider, quilt, felt, bead, etc. The only thing the mask must be is functional. This is not a juried exhibition. Instead, it is a chance to have fun using your skills to craft a functional 3D work of art, and then put it on parade.



1. **Make a mask or two!**
2. **Submit a photo of your mask.**

Take a picture of your finished mask on your face: a selfie or photo taken by someone else. (Don't want to have your face in the photo? You may also take a photo of your mask by itself—if you can get a good photo!)

3. **Send the photo to Mary Valerie Richter at fibercats@comcast.net by September 30, 2020.** (If submitting multiple masks, send one email per mask.)

Include your name, title of your mask, and materials and techniques used.

Please send the largest image possible from your Smartphone or check the photo submission size guidelines in the password protected member section of [AAFG Website](#) for sending jpeg images.

Our October Zoom membership meeting will feature a show and tell of Functional COVID Art Masks. Mary will also post an on-line exhibition on our AAFG Facebook page in October and Liz Ritter will post a slide show on the AAFG website.
