The Power Center Show is an annual exhibit of artwork created by our Guild members. The show is hung in the lobby, where audience members gather and mingle before performances and during intermissions. Work may be viewed anytime the Power Center is offering a concert or performance. The lobby opens a half-hour prior to a performance, and you do not need a ticket to enter the lobby. Power Center is a wonderful venue for large 2D pieces (2' x 2' minimum).

- **To be eligible to exhibit you must have:**
 - paid your 2022-2023 AAFG membership dues
 - your work accepted by the exhibit jurors

- **Eligible Work**
 - 2D pieces. Work may be composed of a single piece, or a composition of several smaller works, constructed to hang as a unit.
 - Work that has previously been exhibited at the Power Center Show venue is not eligible.
 - Work that was shown at Cherry Hill may be eligible.
 - The jury committee has agreed that work produced during the last 5 years, if not shown before, is eligible for both shows. "Key" pieces, if not dated in style, may also be considered.
 - Please review the newly revised [AAFG Guidelines for Exhibitors](#).
 - Work must be ready to hang. Please bear in mind that the plugs for hanging work are spaced two feet apart, vertically and horizontally.
 - Cindy and Anne will coordinate the hanging of the show.

- **Commission**
 - The AAFG accesses a 20% commission.

- **Jury Date**
