

## **EMBROIDERY**

- Embroidery is the art of working raised and ornamental designs in threads upon woven fabric, paper, leather, etc. with a needle. Mark making is not embroidery.
- Embroidery is a well-defined technique; how can you adapt and change it to your style?
- Evaluate the work and add as needed. "It is not finished until it is finished."

## **JURY CONSIDERATIONS**

### **ARTISTRY (originality and creativity)**

- Has the maker defined the technique in a personal style?
- Is the design original to the maker?
- Does the embroidery design work for the piece?

### **WORKMANSHIP**

- For 2D work, has it been reinforced to create stability?
- If stitches are not intended to be shown, have they been hidden?
- Are there no loose dangling threads?

### **USABILITY**

- Is the work labeled for washing or dry cleaning?
